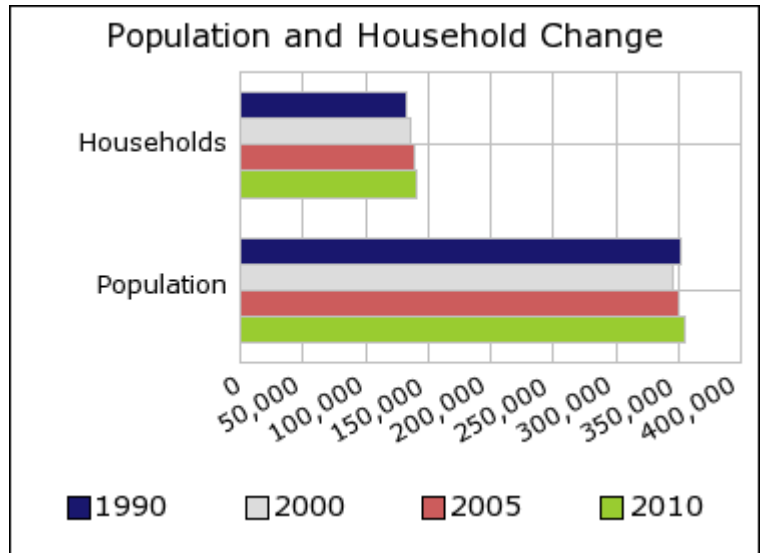

Population Demographics:

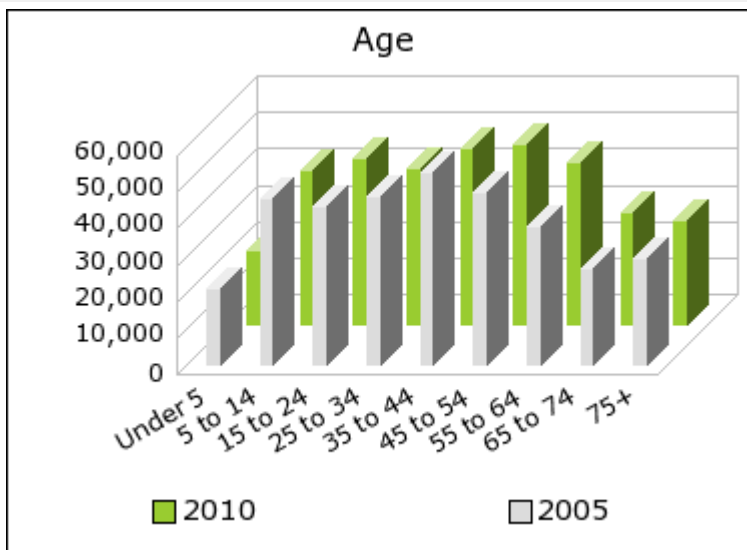
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **132,293** and changed to **136,733** in 2000, representing a change of **3.4%**. The household count in 2005 was **138,911** and the household projection for 2010 is **140,412**, a change of **1.1%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **352,659** and in 2000 it was **345,631**, roughly a **-2.0%** change. The population in 2005 was **350,293** and the projection for 2010 is **354,560** representing a change of **1.2%**.

Population by Age



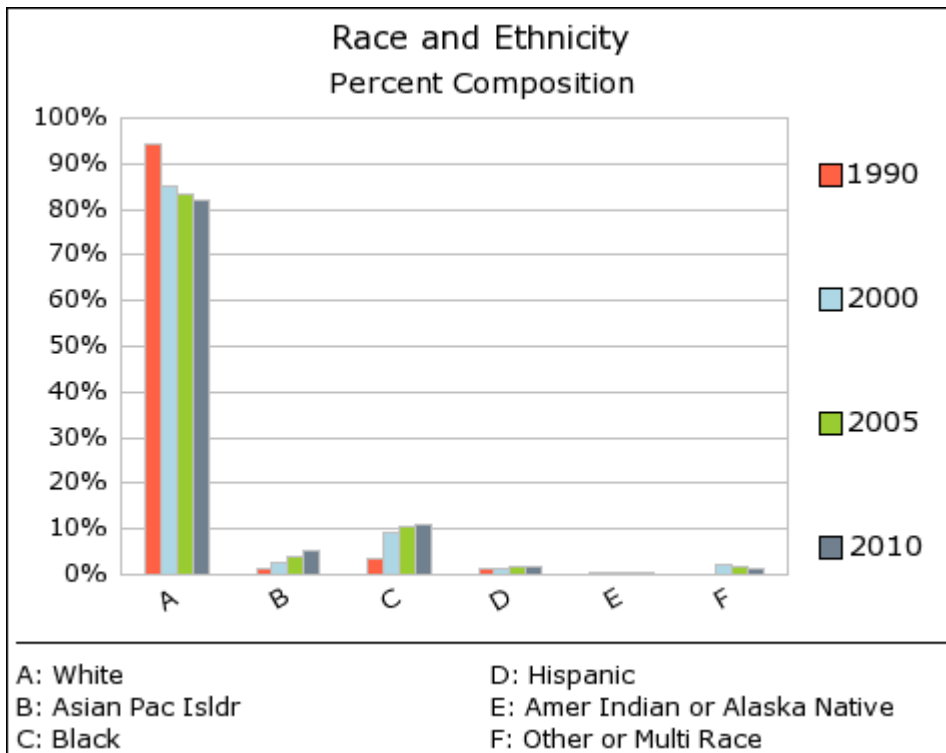
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34.7**, and in 2000, it was **36.9**. The median age in 2005 is **38.6** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40.5** years. In 2005, females represented **51.5%** of the population with a median age of **40.4** and males represented **48.5%** of the population with a median age of **36.9** years. In 2005, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity

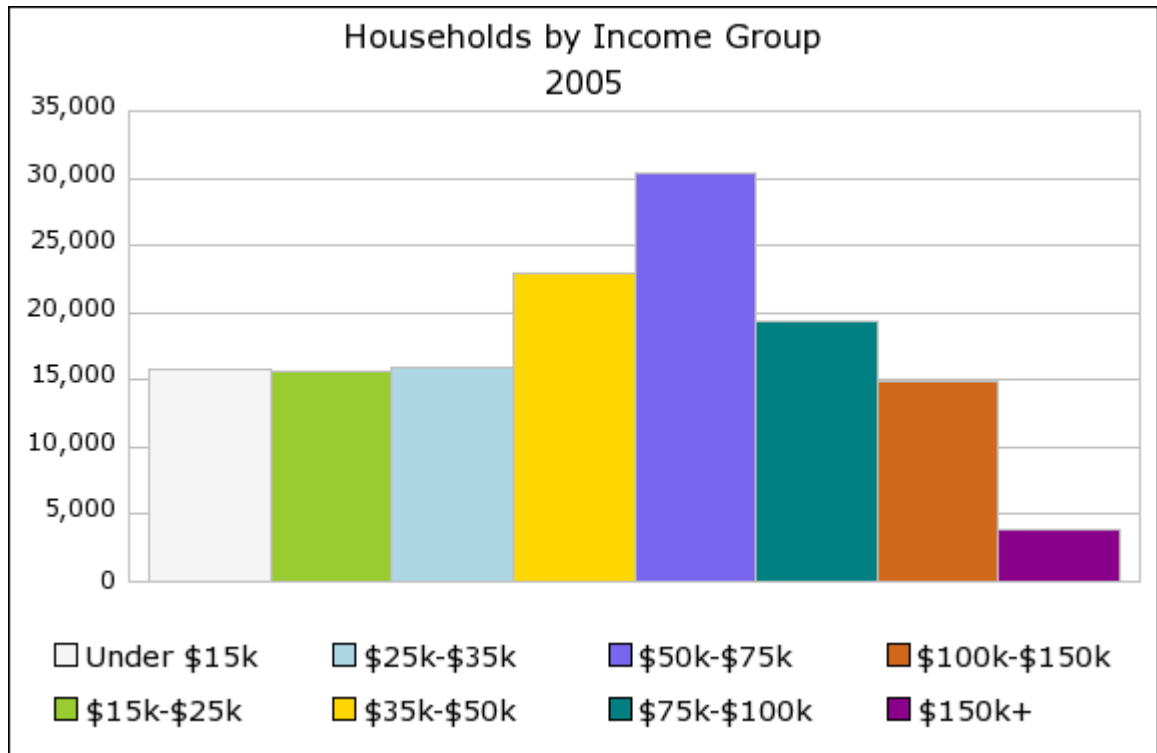


In 2005, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Other**.
