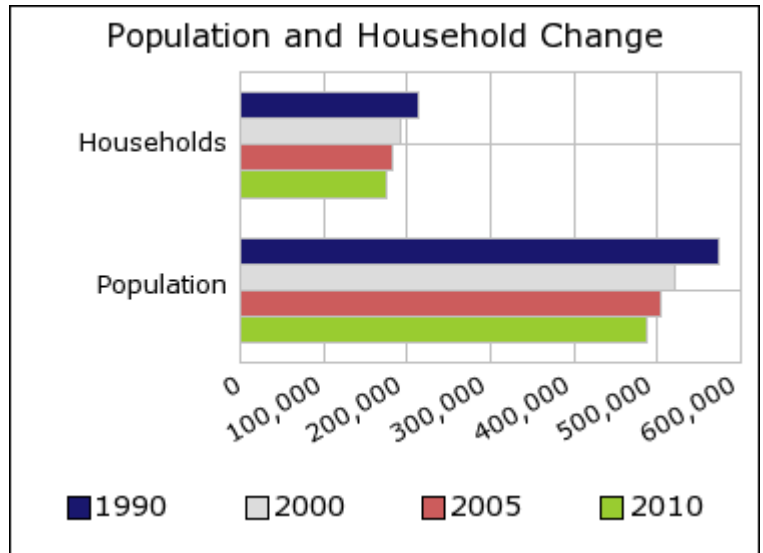

Population Demographics:

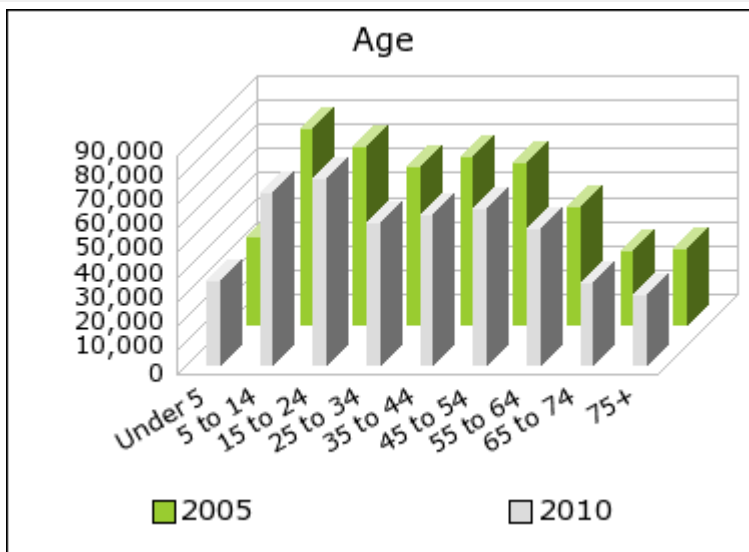
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **214,267** and changed to **191,202** in 2000, representing a change of **-10.8%**. The household count in 2005 was **183,298** and the household projection for 2010 is **175,727**, a change of **-4.1%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **574,337** and in 2000 it was **521,075**, roughly a **-9.3%** change. The population in 2005 was **503,211** and the projection for 2010 is **486,918** representing a change of **-3.2%**.

Population by Age

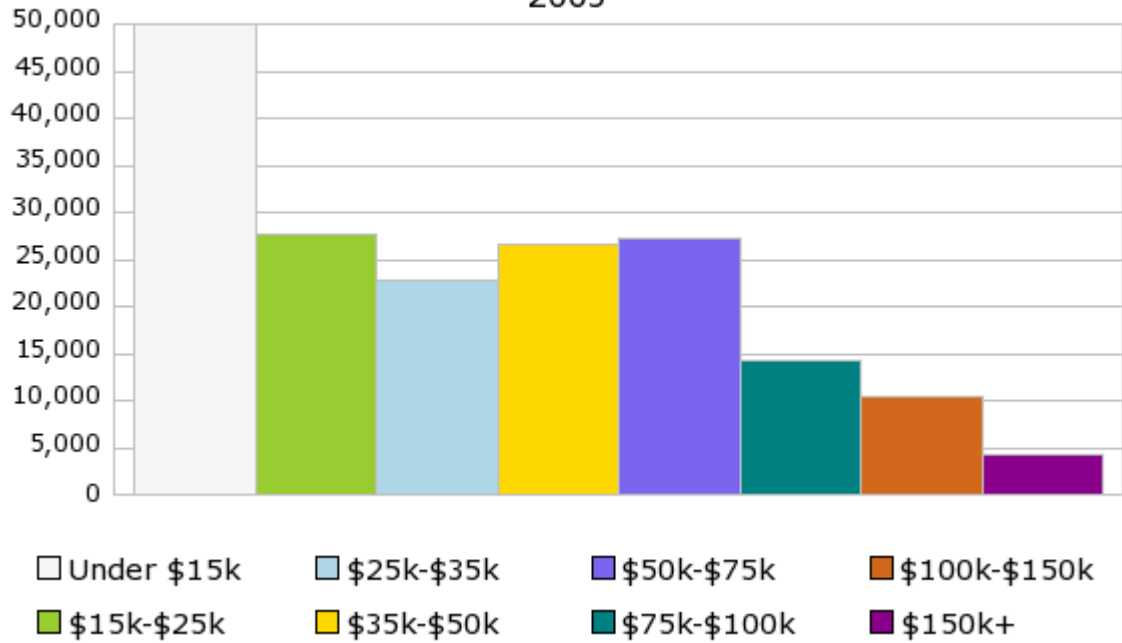


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32.0**, and in 2000, it was **32.5**. The median age in 2005 is **34.3** and it is predicted to change in five years to **35.3** years. In 2005, females represented **52.6%** of the population with a median age of **36.0** and males represented **47.4%** of the population with a median age of **32.3** years. In 2005, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **65 to 74** years.
