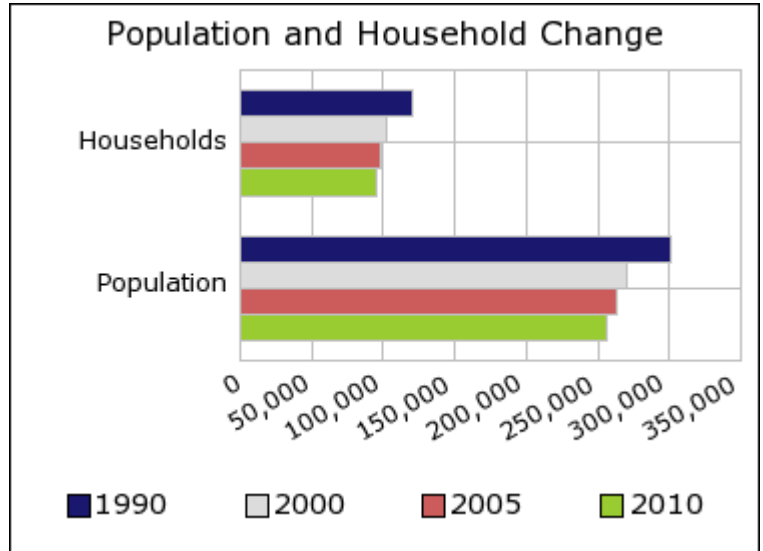

Population Demographics:

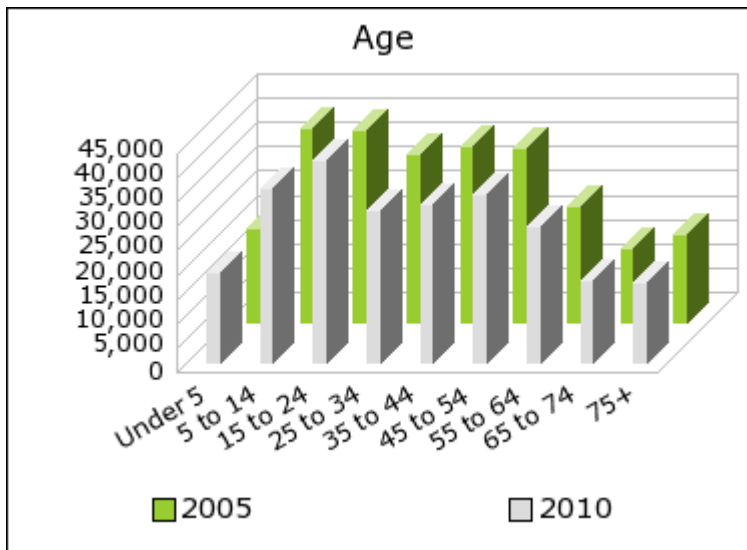
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **120,550** and changed to **101,580** in 2000, representing a change of **-15.7%**. The household count in 2005 was **98,163** and the household projection for 2010 is **94,685**, a change of **-3.5%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **301,154** and in 2000 it was **270,408**, roughly a **-10.2%** change. The population in 2005 was **263,336** and the projection for 2010 is **256,450** representing a change of **-2.6%**.

Population by Age



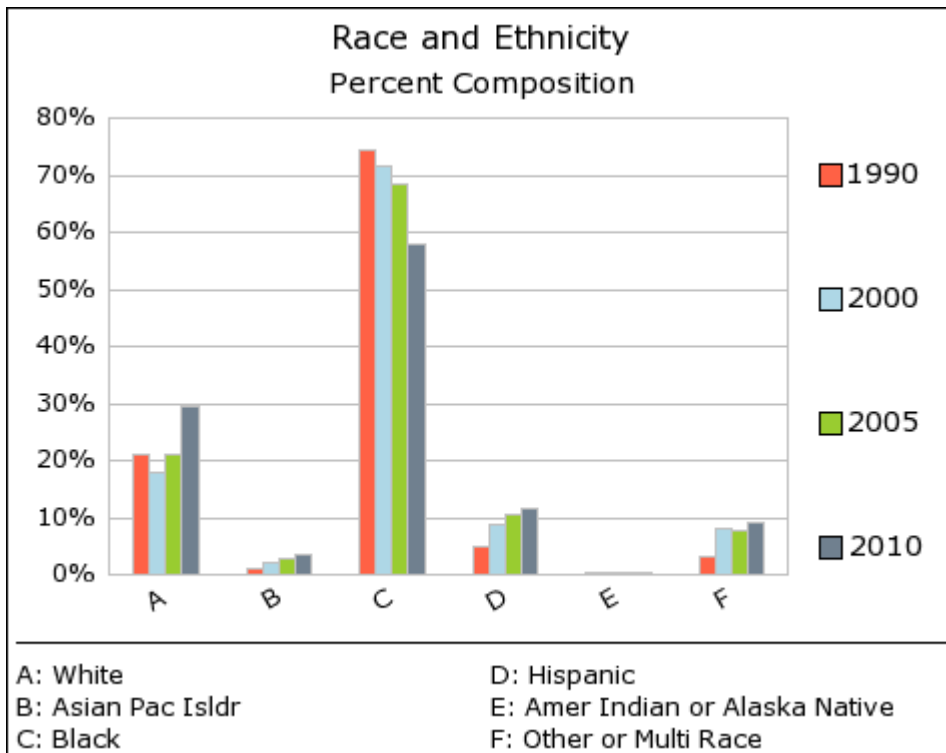
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33.3**, and in 2000, it was **32.8**. The median age in 2005 is **34.5** and it is predicted to change in five years to **35.2** years. In 2005, females represented **51.2%** of the population with a median age of **36.0** and males represented **48.8%** of the population with a median age of **32.9** years. In 2005, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **65 to 74** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity

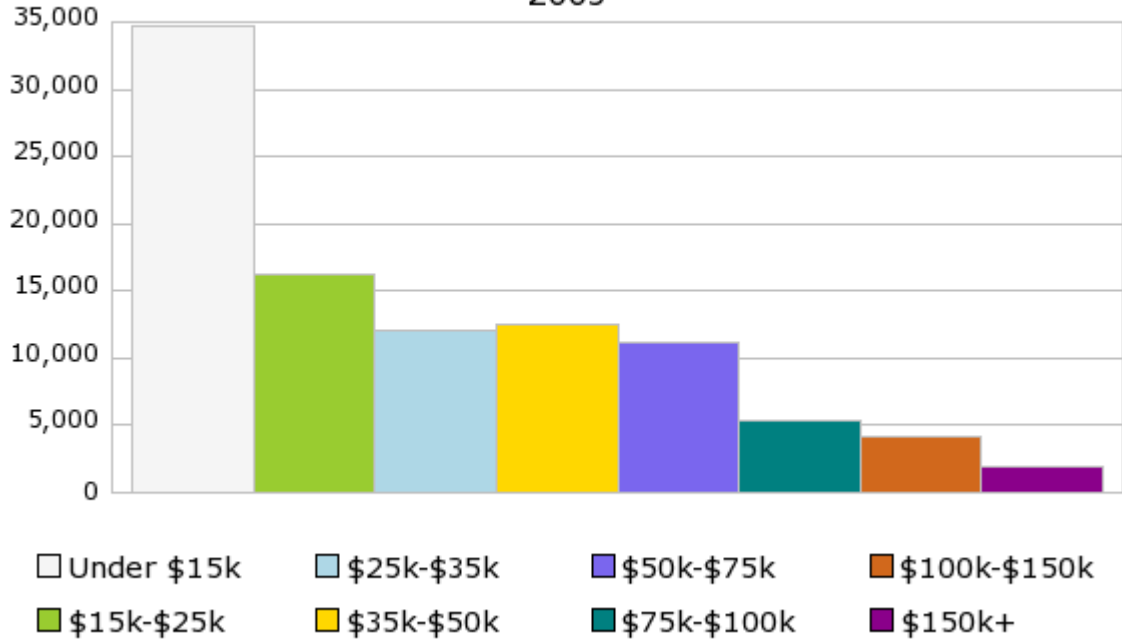


In 2005, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **Black**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.
