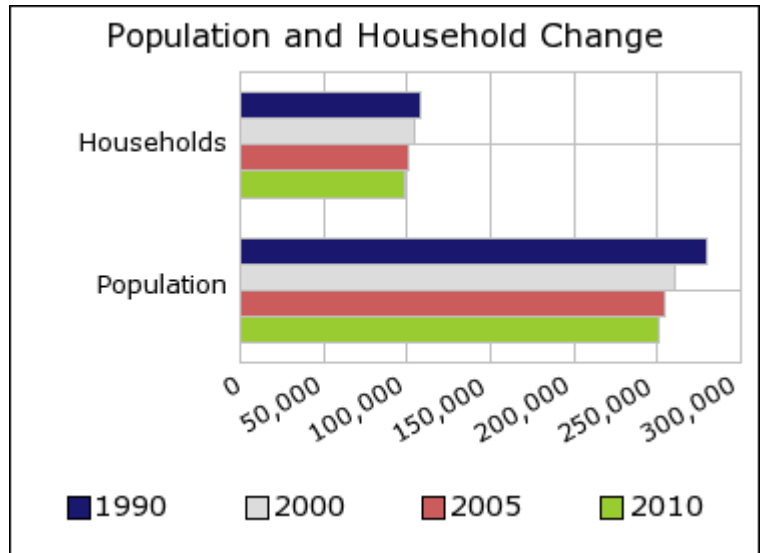

Population Demographics:

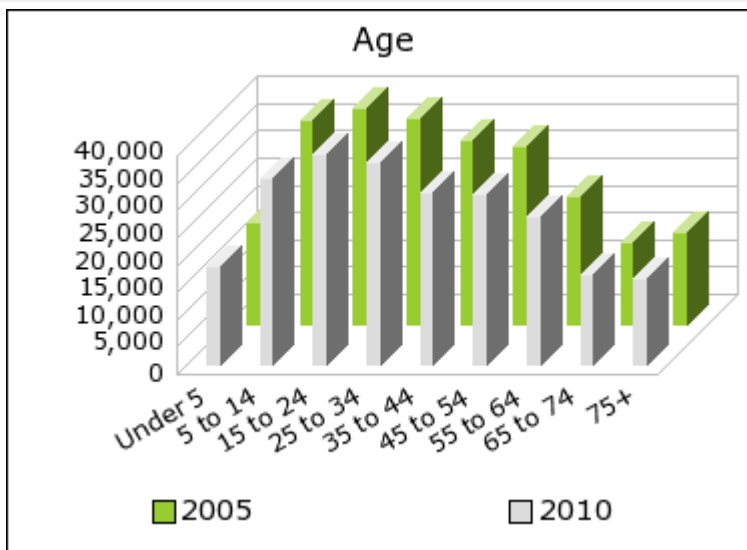
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **107,786** and changed to **104,182** in 2000, representing a change of **-3.3%**. The household count in 2005 was **101,272** and the household projection for 2010 is **98,503**, a change of **-2.7%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **279,237** and in 2000 it was **260,173**, roughly a **-6.8%** change. The population in 2005 was **254,985** and the projection for 2010 is **250,444** representing a change of **-1.8%**.

Population by Age



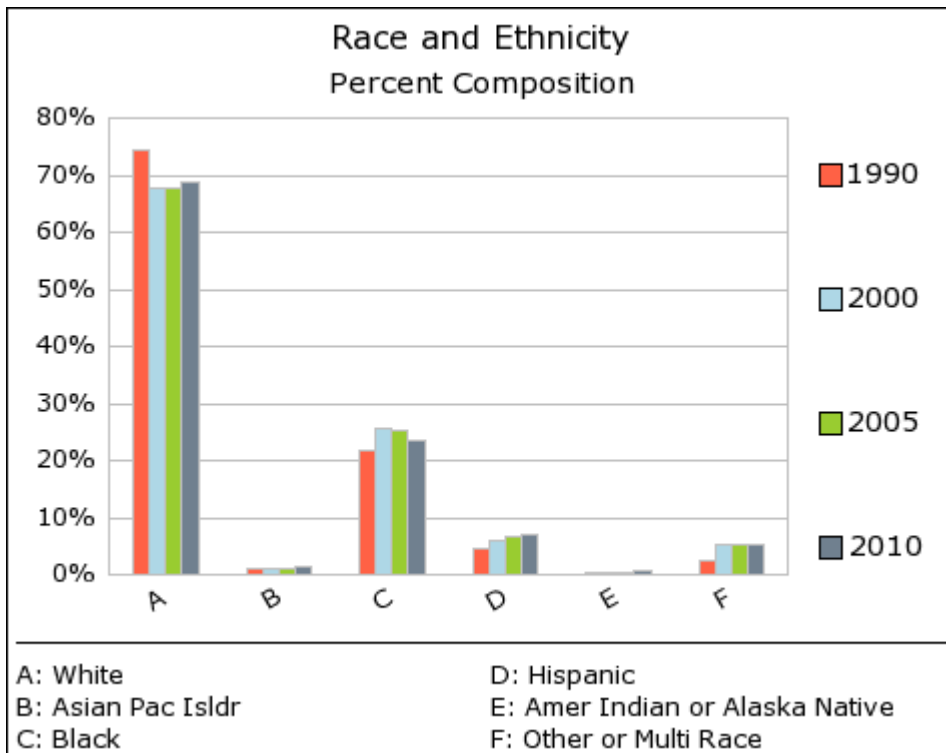
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **31.3**, and in 2000, it was **32.6**. The median age in 2005 is **33.4** and it is predicted to change in five years to **34.2** years. In 2005, females represented **51.7%** of the population with a median age of **35.0** and males represented **48.3%** of the population with a median age of **31.8** years. In 2005, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 25 to 34** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **65 to 74** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity

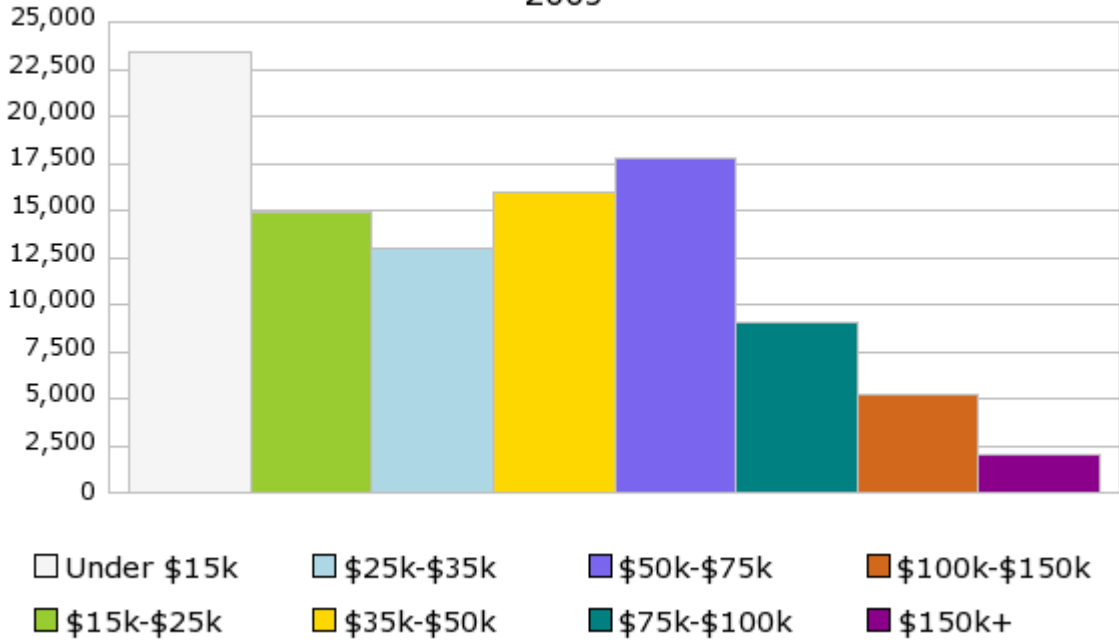


In 2005, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.
